



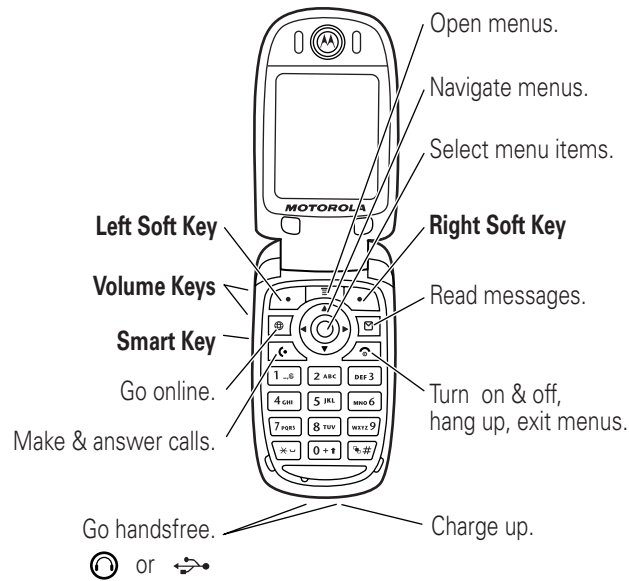



This guide shows how to locate a menu feature as follows:

Find it: Press  >  **Recent Calls** > **Dialed Calls**

This example shows that, from the home screen, you press the *menu key*  to open the menu. Scroll to and select  **Recent Calls**, then scroll to and select **Dialed Calls**.

Press the *navigation key*  to scroll to a menu feature. Press the *center key*  to select the highlighted menu feature.

This means a feature is network/subscription dependent and may not be available in all areas. Contact your service provider for more information.

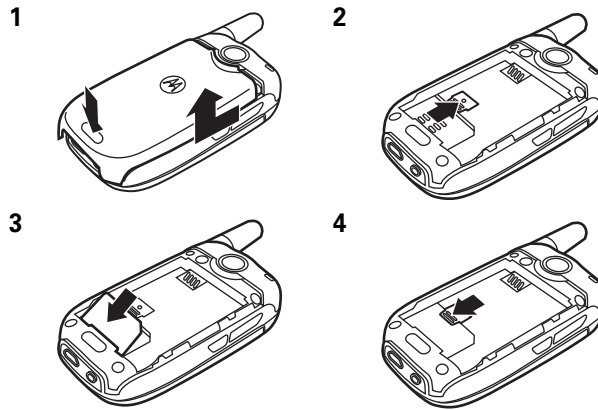


This means a feature requires an optional accessory.
